Data Protection Policy

Who we are:

The data policy holder is Amy Weller and is compliant with the General Data Protection Regulations. Amy is the owner and operator of the registered business Amy Weller Art. The website, amywellerart.com, is the official website of this registered business, and the website platform used is Wix. Amy Weller is committed to following all data protection laws and the privacy of your data.

Why we collect data about you:

We collect data about you when you visit our website. We collect data about you when you:

- Contact us through a chat box or contact form.
- Sign up for our mailing list.
- Purchase items from our online shop.
- Purchase a subscription plan.

We need to collect data from you so we have accurate and up to date information to contact you, and so that we are able to process requests, orders, subscriptions, payments, and delivery.

What data we collect about you:

The data we collect about you is as follows:

Comments:

- When you leave a comment in a chat box, we collect data shown in the comments form, and also the visitors IP address and browser agent to aid with spam detection. This information is stored privately and securely.

Media:

- If you are a member and are sharing media to the shared gallery, you should avoid uploading images with embedded

location data (EXIF GPS) included, as this can be downloaded by other users and location information extracted.

Contact forms or email enquiries:

If you contact us through a contact form or email, then we may collect the following data from you:

- Your full name.
- Your contact details such as telephone number or email address.
- We may need other personal details from you such as photographs if you are ordering commission works (such as photos of your pets).

Mailing lists:

If you sign up for our mailing list, then we will collect the following information from you:

- Your name.
- Your email address.
- Your consent to email you with promotional offers, sales, updates, and more.

Online shop:

When you make a purchase from our online shop, then we collect the following information about you:

- Your name.
- Your shipping/ billing address.
- Your contact details, such as a telephone number.
- Your payment/ card details.

Subscription plans:

If you become a subscriber and join a subscription plan, then we collect the following information from you:

- Your name.
- Your email address.

- Your payment/ card details.
- Your contact details.

Other information:

There may be times when we may need to collect more personal data from you. For example, if you have placed an order for a pet portrait commission, you will need to email photographs of your pet(s), as reference photos are needed to complete the art work.

Any other personal information that is needed from you will be discussed and explained to you at the time of contact.

Cookies:

If you leave a comment on the site, then you may opt in to saving your details so you don't have to fill your details in again. These cookies will last up to one year.

We set up a temporary cookie on our login page to determine how you want to accept cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close down the page.

When you login, there's several cookies that have been set up to save your login information and on screen choices. There's also cookies when you select 'sign up' and 'forgot password'. The expiring times for these cookies may vary.

Embedded content from other websites:

This website may include embedded content from other websites. Embedded content can include links, pictures, videos, etc.

Embedded content from other websites may also collect personal data about you, use cookies, track your saved profiles and preferences, and more.

Who we share your data with:

We are committed to protecting your personal data and will never share your data with any third parties, unless required by law or security reasons.

Our website provider is Wix who will have a record of personal information that is being stored, as well as their site centres.

Website administrators can see and have access to personal data, but your data is always secured confidentially and safely. Website members will have access to their own data and can amend their details through their own account.

Visitor comments may be checked through an automated spam detection system.

How we protect your data:

We are committed to storing your data securely on our site. Our website provider Wix has implemented various safety measures to keep your data safe and secure, and to prevent misuse or breaches of data. We have taken the following measures to protect your data:

- Two factor authentication: Two factor authentication is enabled for an added layer of security when administrators log in. They must enter a one time password to log in and manage the site.
- Authorised devices: We have set up authorised devices to access and manage the site. This means that only approved devices have access to managing the site and personal information. We do not use any mobile or wireless devices when managing the site for an extra security measure. This is in case devices are accidentally lost or stolen.
- Secure access: Wix operates a secure access service which allows users to make payment transactions safely and securely.
- Vulnerability and protection: Wix operates regular security checks through their security provider to ensure the security of the site.

Where we store data about you:

Our website provider is Wix and your personal data is stored on our Wix website here at amywellerart.com. Data is stored on our own

approved device that has implemented the security measures as listed above, as well as security protection being placed on the device too.

Your personal data will be stored at Wix, including their site centres located in the United States of America, Ireland, and Israel.

Personal data is always stored confidentially and securely.

How long we retain data:

When a visitor leaves a comment, their information is stored indefinitely so that we can recognise and approve any follow up comments.

For users that register with our website (for example through subscriptions) we store information provided in their membership profile. All users have access to their own personal data and can change, edit, or delete information at any time (except for their username). Users can make information private or public. Website administrators can also see and edit this information too.

Your rights over your data:

You have the right to request a copy of the data we hold about you at any time, as well as the right to amend, or delete your personal data that we hold about you. That does not include information that we are legally obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security reasons.
